Announcements from MoEUCC regarding KKDİK registrations

1) 4th March 2026

“As is known, the registration obligations regarding substances manufactured or imported under the KKDİK Regulation, are processed within the framework of the Procedures and Principles regarding the implementation of KKDİK.

Within the framework of the Procedures and Principles published on 5 August 2025, a Chemicals Advisory Group was established. To ensure that KKDİK registration processes are carried out by industry in a simple, fast and effective manner, meetings of the Chemicals Advisory Group held several meetings. As a result of these meetings, due to difficulties encountered in determination of Lead Registrants (LR), it was decided that allowing temporary individual registrations would constitute a fast and effective solution.

In this context, submission of individual temporary registration dossiers will be carried out by companies through the (KKS), provided that the justification is clearly stated.

Companies should be informed that “individual temporary registrations must be completed before the deadline as 30 September 2026.”

2) 6th March 2026

The establishment of the national chemicals inventory is of critical importance. Within the framework of creating the national chemicals inventory, companies are required to submit their Individual Temporary Registrations for substances to the Ministry by 30 September 2026, irrespective of the tonnage band of the substance.

Where certain information required under Annex-1 of the Procedures and Principles cannot be obtained or accessed, the relevant temporary registration dossiers may still be submitted, provided that the missing information is documented in the KKS together with a justification.

The missing information and documentation may subsequently be updated through the KKS until the final registration deadlines set out in the Regulation.

Following **30 September 2026**, the Ministry will carry out the necessary inspections and verifications regarding the temporary or full registration numbers **of substances manufactured or imported by companies**.

For **substances that will be manufactured or imported for the first time after 30 September 2026**, companies must first **submit an inquiry for temporary or full registration prior to the manufacture or import**, obtain the relevant **registration number**, and continue their activities in compliance with the Regulation.

For substances for which a **full registration dossier has already been submitted by a Lead Registrant**, member companies may submit their **individual Temporary registrations** through the Chemical Registration System, provided that the relevant justification is stated (e.g. **disproportionate cost sharing, confidentiality concerns, or disagreements among registrants**).

Companies that have already submitted and obtained a **full registration number** for a substance are **not required to obtain a Temporary registration number** for the same substance.
